Tips for teaching "Count on Me"

-  Make sure your student is very familiar with the melody of this song before trying to sing along. Once they know the melody, playing and singing together is easy.
-  Students have the option of doing the second verse and chorus or ending at the end of the first chorus with the C Major chord.
