I'm starting with the man in the mirror

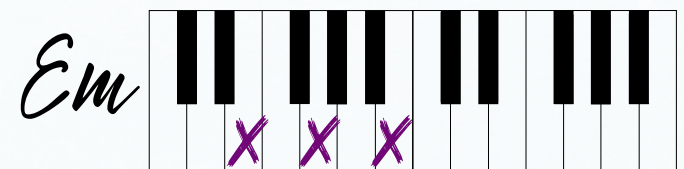
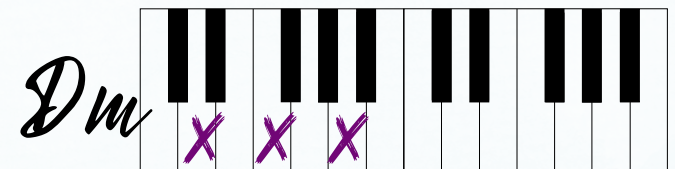
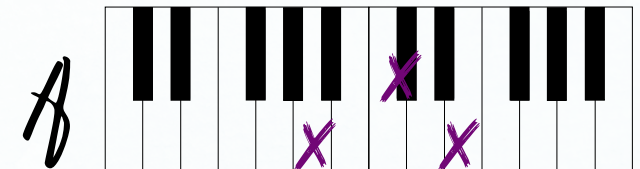
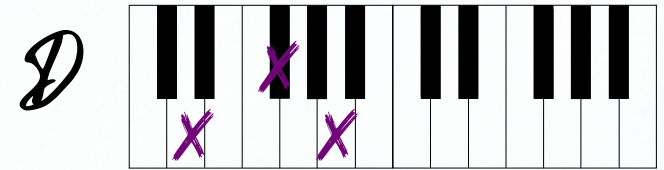
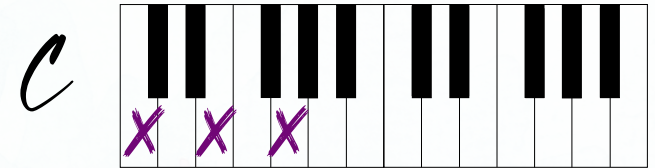
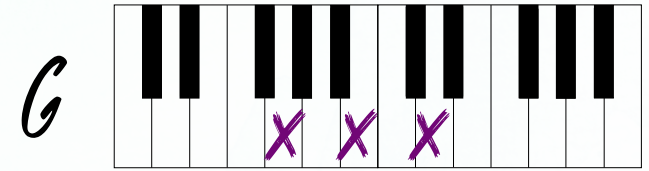

Tips for Teaching "Man in the Mirror"



This song gives us another great opportunity to teach chord notation like G/B (means to play the G chord in it's first inversion or B in the bass).



In the first line of the song this creates a really nice pattern of ascending notes. Don't miss this teachable moment! Talk about constructing bass lines within the chord structure.
