## Tips for teaching chords

""Good 4 U" by Olivia Rodrigo has been a big hit since it came out in 2021. In addition to getting a lot of airtime on the radio, the song started trending on TikTok so chances are pretty good that your students know it well.

I chose this song because it's more up-tempo than most of the songs I've covered so far. Use this song as an opportunity to get the left hand moving. Consider incorporating octaves and repeated eighth-note patterns.

Why do I only do the chorus? Because then I send my students off to use their own ears to figure out the rest of the song! (or not- sometimes they are satisfied with just the chorus and we move on to another song)
