## Tips for teaching "Blank Space"



New concept alert! Students who are new to chord charts may not have seen the "N.C." marking. It means "No Chord". If you listen to the original you'll hear it- the music stops and she sings "*and I'll write your name*".



Optional: The Gm chord in this song is actually a Gm7. I chose to simplify it for this chart but feel free to add the F in it if you like!
