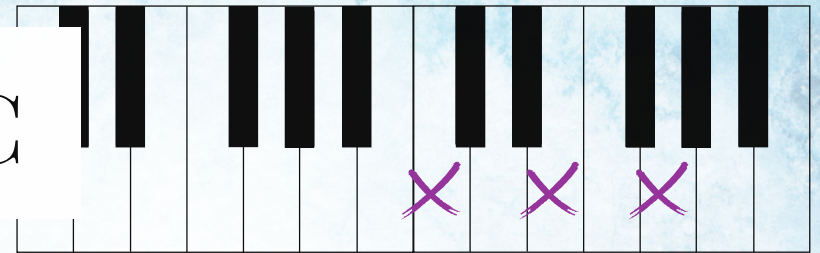

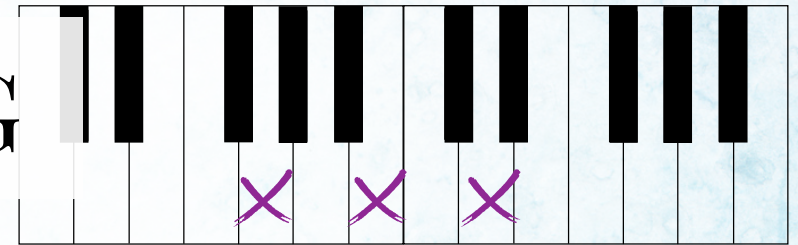

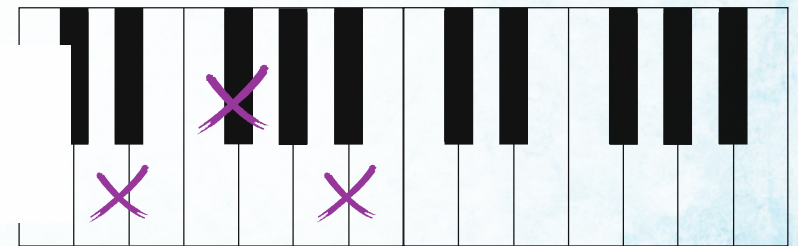

Tips for teaching "The Nights"



Since this song doesn't have a strong piano part to focus on in the recording, pianists will have the opportunity to be creative and make their own cover of the song!



In the last line we introduce G/D which means to play a G chord with "D" in the bass. This will likely be a new concept for students (and maybe teachers too!). I recommend playing the entire G chord in the right hand and the note D in the left.

Experiment rhythmically to give the song a feeling of forward motion to reflect the lyrics
